Our unit works in partnership with multidisciplinary team members including Consultants, Registrars, Junior Doctors, Physios, Occupational Therapists, Speech Pathology, Dieticians, Pharmacists and Administration Officers PLUS a range of skilled nurses to provide specialised care relevant to their specialty or area of study.
